## 2 Summary information

A short stay, 'C' class, visit visa allows you to travel to Ireland, for a maximum of 90 days (in any 180 day period), for tourism, to visit family or friends, to study, to get married or for medical treatment. A short stay 'C' visit visa does not allow you to do work (paid or unpaid) of any kind, or use any publicly funded services, for example a public hospital.
